



HISTORY OF JRMSU

Jose Rizal Memorial State University was established by virtue of RA 9852 with Congresswoman Cecilia G. Jalosjos-Carreon as principal author, Congressman Cesar Jalosjos as co-author. It was approved by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo on December 15, 2009. It was formerly the Jose Rizal Memorial State College by virtue of RA 8193 sponsored by Congressman Romeo G. Jalosjos of the 1st District of Zamboanga del Norte which was approved on June 11, 1996 by the President of the Republic, Fidel V. Ramos. It was a consolidation of the Rizal Memorial Vocational School (RMNVS) in Dapitan City, the Zamboanga del Norte School of Arts and Trades (ZNSAT) in Dipolog City, and the Siocon National Vocational School (SNVS) in the Municipality of Siocon. In 2002, two higher education institutions (HEIs) within Zamboanga del Norte, namely the Katipunan National Agricultural School (KNAS) in the municipality of Katipunan and the Zamboanga del Norte Agricultural College (ZNAC) in the Municipality of Tampilisan, were integrated into then JRMSC pursuant to CHED Memorandum Order No. 27 series of 2000 thus comprising the fourth and fifth campuses, respectively of JRMSU.

The first President was Dr. Felipe O. Ligan who was appointed in 1997. On June 7, 2002 CHED Special Order No. 35, s. 2002 appointed Dr. Henry A. Sojor as the OIC President of the Jose Rizal Memorial State College in concurrent capacity as President of Central Visayas Polytechnic College in Dumaguete City now Negros Oriental State University.

In the span of two years and eight months, the Board of Trustee then deemed it best for the College to have its permanent leader. Thus, on March 1, 2005, Dr. Edgar S. Balbuena assumed office as second President of JRMSC pursuant to BOT Resolution No. 04, series of 2005 Chairmanned by Fr. Rolando V. Rosa, OP.

With the appointment of Dr. Balbuena, the College charted a new course. With his extraordinary leadership it took only four years and nine months for the College to be elevated to the status of a University. Indeed the growth of the University means a continuing and growing commitment for academic excellence and quality, research, and productivity, community involvement and partnership for national development and global competitiveness.

It is with Dr. Edgar S. Balbuena that the school prides itself in maintaining notable performance in licensure examinations conducted by the Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) as evidenced in performance ratings in Licensure/Board Examinations for Teachers (Elementary and Secondary), Maritime Education, Midwifery, Criminology, Electronics and Communications Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Nursing and Agriculture with rates way beyond national passing percentage. In addition, JRMSU was declared hall of famer in National Rizal and History Quiz edging big State Universities and Colleges all throughout the Philippines. It also excelled in Math Challenge and other battle of the brains contests. Their achievements are manifestations of quality and excellence in education offered by the University. Alongside academic excellence, JRMSU also demonstrates exemplary performance in extra-curricular activities and competitions consistently qualifying in regional, national and international show grounds.

With the school employing highly qualified and goal-driven teachers, the academic community envisions to embrace a growing number of productive and calibre graduates every fruitful and competitive academic year.

Meanwhile, JRMSU competently performed the mandate of conducting research in concomitance with the development plan of the region and the national government, instigating culture and environment as the leading themes for research among the constituents of the academic community. It spearheads research-driven and demand-driven community extension programs in its thrust to involve the school and the community in the collective pursuit to improve the quality of life through agricultural and livelihood endeavors like the Gawad Kalinga: Barangay Walang Iwanan Program, IWash Program and the One Baranggay - One Product (OBOP) collaborative projects among others. The University conducted researches/ extension programs not for the sole purpose of compliance but for the reason of serving the community by disseminating findings of community need-based researches.

In its relentless pursuit for quality education through the years, JRMSU is also acclaimed as one of the Top Performing SUCs in the Philippines according to the Accrediting Agency of Chartered Colleges and Universities in the Philippines Incorporated (AACCCUP) yielding AACCCUP Accredited course offering and programs. Now JRMSU, with ISO 9001-2015 Certification for Quality Management System (Design, Development and Delivery of Services in Education, Research and Community Extension including Administration and Management) granted by the Global Group, it progress to efficiently and effectively serve the clientele as well as the community better.

The competent workforce of the University is also significantly attributed to its exceptional optimists who effectively corroborate and complement the dynamic efforts and initiatives of the University President specifically: Dr. Evelyn R. Campiseño, Vice – President for Research, Extension and Development, Dr. Reynaldo M. Venezuela, Vice – President for Administration and Finance and Dr. Aida O. Lanioso, VP for Academic Affairs.

As JRMSU traverses another academic mile with the new President in the person of Dr. Daylinda Luz Laput, it continues to dedicate and commit in delivering quality and excellent services across its four mandated functions instruction, research, extension and production along various faculty and student development programs, so as to address the needs, demands and challenges of today's generation.
